

Slavery and human trafficking statement

This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and sets out the steps we have taken to ensure that our business as well as our supply chains are free from slavery and human trafficking during the financial year ending 31 .03.2017.

Introduction

Our organisational structure and operations

Stanton Bonna Concrete Ltd is a manufacturer of precast concrete pipes and manholes as part of a comprehensive range of Drainage Systems, Pressure Systems, Railway Products and Specialist Precast solutions. We manufacture for the water, highways, rail, housing, telecom and power sectors of the construction industry.

Stanton Bonna Concrete employs circa 150 employees and operates in the UK.

We are part of the Consolis Group, our parent company has its head office in Paris, France. The Group employs 10,000 people worldwide and operates in 30 countries.

Nature of our supply chains

Our supply chains include the sourcing of raw materials principally related to the manufacture of precast concrete products.

Policies relating to slavery and human trafficking

In order to monitor and mitigate the risks of slavery and human trafficking occurring within our supply chains we endeavour to:


- Build long standing relationships with our suppliers and make clear our expectations of business behaviour
